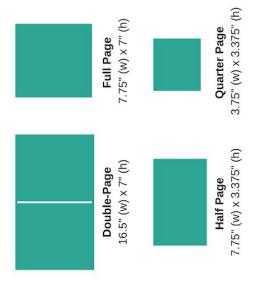

PDF X1-A: An Adobe Acrobat hi-res "Press Quality" PDF file is the preferred format. All fonts must be embedded. All color ads must be designed using CMYK process color space. Spot colors will be converted to CMYK. Files must be submitted at 100% of reproduction size. All embedded images must be 300 dpi TIFF or EPS files.

Adobe Illustrator EPS and Photoshop TIFF or EPS files are also accepted.
